It provides the orphan children with a healthy, pollution free environment, security, good nutritious food, medical & health care, satisfactory level of education and skill training to make them self-sufficient. On arriving there, the group was greeted warmly by the kids and founder of Orphanage. It currently houses 55 kids and 3 caretakers. The group got a quick tour of the place, which has 3 dormitories, a separate dining room, play room, music room, class room and computer lab. After the tour, the students spent time with the kids, talking to them, playing games with the younger ones, and seeing some of the older ones sing & play the guitar in the Music room. The orphanage is in need of funds for building extra rooms for kids . To help them, funds were collected from the students and faculty members of the College. The purpose of the visit was to sensitize the students of GEC to the hardships of under-privileged children, and try to inculcate in them a habit of contributing towards the less fortunate, and spread awareness of such causes. As the students will go on to become working professionals & businessmen, hopefully this visit will make them realize their social responsibility of giving back to the society that they belong to.
