



4. Actively participating in the Swachha Bharat Abhiyan by conducting programs like cleaning the college campus.


5. The Department has also organized city cleaning programs like making people aware about 'the ban on single use plastic' on occasions like Gandhi Jayanti,College Foundation Day.


HEALTHY PRACTICES ADOPTED BY THE DEPT.






