#### INTRODUCTION

The Department of Psychology is one of the premier departments of the college being initiated in the year 1969 with intermediate course under Utkal University. This small department with only sixteen students has become matured one. It is now able to produce 40+ Psychology Graduates every year. Some of them are well established being able-administers, Lecturers and teachers. Some of our students have also been able to lead our society. Our ex-honourable minister school and mass education Sj. Samir Ranjan Dash is the bright example. He happens to be a student of this department during 1985-87.

In course of our scholastic journey five of our illuminators have completed their journey getting superannuated in their job. It is noteworthy that all of them were accorded with UGC Teachers' Fellowship to pursue their PhD Degree. From all the present faculty members one has also with PhD degree and one is continuing his PhD.

It is important to mention that around 10% of our pass-out students continued their higher study in B. Ed., LLB, MBA, Rural Management, and M.A.in Psychology at different institutions. Some of them have been well placed. Three students have become college teachers after completing MA & MPhil courses. One of our alma mater, Mr. Abhijit Pati is serving in Regional Institute of Education, Bhubaneswar as the school counsellor since February, 2019. Another student of our department — Jyoshil Bhol is serving as Clinical Psychologist under SSEPD department, Government of Odisha. Besides, every year a dozen of students are placed in OSAP, CRPF, BSF, CISF, and ITBF.

If we go through the results of +3 Psychology Honours, it is evident that the number of students getting first division and distinction every year is three times of the number of students admitted with second division.
